NJHS is a service organization and has high academic criteria. Members participate in individual and group community service projects. Application for the school year is open only to students who satisfy the outline criteria. Please see the links below for more information.

Membership Requirements

Academic Criteria

- 7th and 8th Grade Students
- Students are eligible with an overall average of > 90% in 2nd semester of last year.
- Straight A's are NOT required, but all grades must average out to > 90%.
- If you do not have a copy of last year's report card, we can verify grades AFTER you submit the application.

Conduct

- Student must have 2 teacher recommendations based on behavior and leadership.
- Students must maintain outstanding conduct, and must not have received any N's or U's during each nine weeks, of the previous two quarters.
- Applying students must not have any ISS or OSS suspensions, and may not have more than
 one detention, during the previous two quarters. Once admitted, students will be removed for
 any suspensions, and will be placed on probation if they receive an after school detention.

Community and School Service Hours

- NJHS members must complete 10 hours of community service. A maximum of 5 hours can be completed on campus.
- Character is a core value of NJHS we are operating on the Honor System!

Meeting Attendance

- NJHS will meet once a month, after school (4:00-5:00) on Thursday afternoons. Make-up meetings for student athletes will be on Friday morning, at 8:20.
- Students who do not meet the meeting requirement may be suspended from the organization.

Students are expected to attend all meetings. If a student cannot attend a meeting due to a school sponsored activity, he or she must notify Mrs. Thomas BEFORE the meeting, and attend the alternate meeting time.
