- 4. On pg. 5, you **only** need to enter a Physical Address **if it's different** than the Permanent Address you entered on pg. 4.
- 5. Pg. 8 High School Information. Type "McKinney Boyd High School", enter the name in the Search box.
  - a. Enter your approximate Graduate Date ex. 05/25/2023, 05/25/2024, 05/25/2025
  - b. A GED **only** applies if you drop out of high school.
- 6. Pg. 9 No, you've never taken college classes unless you've taken dual credit at another high school (not including dual credit through Collin College). AP credit does not count either.
- Pg. 10 Question about how long you've lived in Texas: By the time you graduate high school, will you have lived in Texas during 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grade?
  - a. If you answer yes, you'll only see two additional questions.
  - b. If you answer no, you will see additional questions about parent/legal guardian.
  - c. Once you've answered all the questions, click Done. BUT you're not done.
