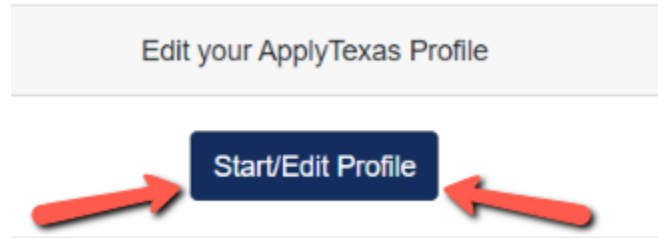


Step-by-Step Guide to Apply Texas

1. Create an account at www.goapplytexas.org
2. Start/Edit your profile



- a. Enter your personal information
3. On pg. 3, "Are you a U.S. Citizen". If answer is No, you will see additional questions:

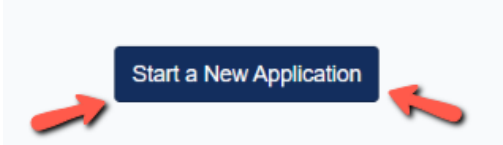
If you have an Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) and do NOT have a Social Security Number filled in above, please enter it here. Otherwise, please leave blank.

4. On pg. 5, you **only** need to enter a Physical Address **if it's different** than the Permanent Address you entered on pg. 4.
5. Pg. 8 – High School Information. Type "McKinney Boyd High School", enter the name in the Search box.
 - a. Enter your **approximate** Graduate Date ex. 05/25/2023, 05/25/2024, 05/25/2025
 - b. A GED **only** applies if you drop out of high school.
6. Pg. 9 – No, you've never taken college classes unless you've taken dual credit at another high school (not including dual credit through Collin College). AP credit does not count either.
7. Pg. 10 – Question about how long you've lived in Texas: By the time you graduate high school, will you have lived in Texas during 10th, 11th, and 12th grade?
 - a. If you answer yes, you'll only see two additional questions.
 - b. If you answer no, you will see additional questions about parent/legal guardian.
 - c. Once you've answered all the questions, click Done. BUT you're not done.
8. On the Apply Texas home page, you will now select "Start/Edit Applications"

12. Then scroll down and you’ll see the box for Collin College application. Click the “+ Admissions Application”:

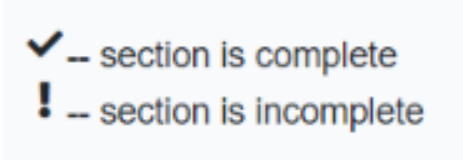

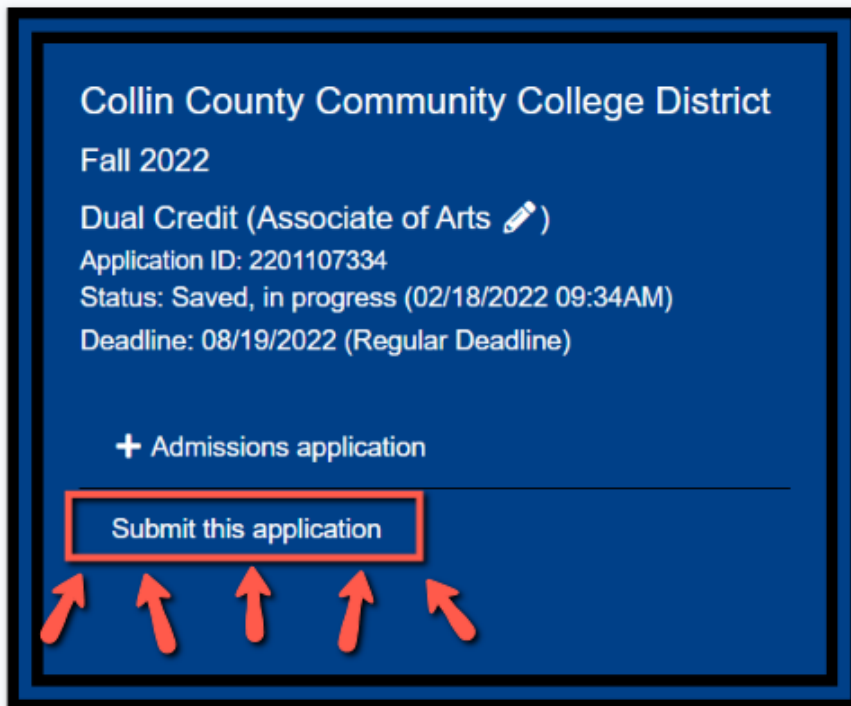
